For information: The state flag of the republic of Uzbekistan was approved on November 18, 1991 at the extraordinary VII session of the supreme council of the republic of Uzbekistan.

The national flag and its symbol represent the historical connection with the states that existed in the past on the national and cultural traditions of the republic.

The blue color on the flag is a symbol of the eternal sky and nature reflecting the meaning of life. In the language of symbols it means goodness, wisdom, honesty, glory and loyalty. Therefore the color of the flag of Amir Temur's state was also blue.

The white color on the flag is a symbol of day, the lights of the universe. White color is a symbol of purity, innocence, purity of dreams and dreams striving for inner beauty.

Green color of nature. It is a symbol of happiness, hope and joy in many nations.

Red lines represent the strands of life, energy flowing in our body.

Flag design: Two red lines separate the horizontal bright green pieces. A crescent and twelve five-pointed stars are to the left of the blue patch.

The symbol of the flag of Uzbekistan continues the best traditions of the flags of the most powerful kingdoms that existed on the territory of the features of the nature of the republic as well as the national and cultural identity of the people.

According to the sources and miniatures of the Sahibqiran period the flag of Amir Temur's state is blue with three oval rings in the middle. In some cases the shape of the flag changed, it became square or triangular. The triangular form was used mainly during military operations due to its convenience. The length of the flag handle is 4-5 meters. On the top of the handle is a helmet or road icon.

This flag of Uzbekistan was officially adopted 30 years ago but its historical roots go back to the middle ages.

The flag of the countries located in the territory of present-day Uzbekistan is the flag of the Timurid empire which existed from the end of the 14th century to the beginning of the 16th century.

Its founder Amir Temur used the image of three circles arranged in a triangle on his personal seal according to the testimony of the Spanish ambassador Ruide Clavijo. They are also minted in coins. Over time this symbol was transferred to the flag of the empire.

However it is not entirely what kind of background it is on-for example the Temur seal is sometimes depicted on a blue dark blue or black ground. Historians still cannot give a clear answer to the question of what this symbol means

According to the most common interpretation the circles represented the three parts of the then-known world (Asia, Europe and Africa) of the flag was understood to be the master of the three continents.

In the time of our great grandfather it was considered uncharacteristic to hold the flag low or let it fall out of a soldier's hand. The owner paid special attention to his. Fouling the flag was a sign of defeat and retreat.

The republic of Uzbekistan has its own state symbols-flag coat of arms and on them approved by law. Therefore freedom, peace and stability of each nation. However no symbol or symbol in the world can recognize a state or a nation to the world like the national flag.

A flag is a great torch that leads us to great goals. It embodies the age-old wishes, enthusiasm and enthusiasm of the entire people of Uzbekistan, the hospitable characteristic of our people. It has been a symbol of independence, freedom, peace and stability for every nation since ancient times.
