Indeed, a person who wants to radiate light and do good, like the sun, should strive for perfection and master various sciences and professions.

We will not be mistaken if we say that in the current period, without perfect study of foreign languages, such milestones cannot be achieved, which our great-grandfather said.

Following such an acute demand, I propose to set the study of physics and foreign languages as a priority next year."

In the modern world, where the English language and professionals who master it well, its comprehensive study requires a thorough formation of all skills. In order to master English at the level of language carriers or at a level close to it, teachers will have to organize exercises, assignments and classes in schools, aimed at mastering all language skills in the educational process, and perform the role of a facilitator (facilitator), and not a traditional teacher in the process of language learning. These language skills are: listening comprehension (listening), speaking (speaking), reading (reading), writing (writing) . In order to achieve the intended goal in language learning, the role of each of these skills is great. Therefore, their assimilation and development will remain one of the necessary tasks of today. Listening comprehension and Reading are considered passive (receptive) skills, since with their help the material of the language is not created, but, on the contrary, they help to receive the material created by others. Writing with speaking, on the other hand, is an active (creative) skill because, in this way, students express their thoughts in the form of oral or written sentences in the form of language material yorda-mida. Thus, active and passive skills are not manifested at one time. Listening before speaking, reading before writing is required (or vice versa).

If the language learner does not fully master each of them and does not use their capabilities correctly, he may not be able to achieve the intended goal. At the same time, students should consider them equally important, since each of them is a separate, independent phenomenon, which is associated with language learning. In addition, teachers should benefit from modern and advanced pedagogical technologies, techniques and approaches in their classes.

Listening comprehension is a skill that must first be formulated among the four skills. All skills are also important, but listening comprehension is more important than all. The reason for this is that he is the guarantor of successful communication. Listening comprehension is a skill that develops faster than speaking, and it, most of the time, also affects reading and writing skills. Without properly formed and effective listening comprehension skills, language learners may not fully understand the message being delivered and communication may not be successful.

Vandergrift states that listening is a complex and active process in which the listener tries to compare the message he hears with his pre-existing knowledge. According to Hadfield's note, listening comprehension is the most difficult skill in mastering a foreign language. It is no secret that most teachers do not look at the development of listening comprehension persuasions with the necessary attention. It is worth saying that when traditional lessons were given, this issue was not given any importance at all. Later, unconventional pedtechnologies develop head-to-head in this regard, a slight shift was prominent. In this regard, Flover DU and Miller say,"as long as the assignments are given by the means of the language being studied, the language learners are buried in that language." Listening comprehension has become one of the most basic tools, especially in the direct method, but as a skill that must be mastered separately by qa-ralmadi, language

learners learn inductively through repeated and repeated hearing of a material. and teachers did not bring assignments aimed at understanding, actively listening to the course process. Similar cases were observed in other audiolingual, grammatical techniques of Language Teaching.

1) Reading

Reading is an important way of gaining information in language learning and it is a basic skills for a language learner. There a lot of reading exercises . But all these readings must be done in limited time . You should read phrase by phrase .Read as much as you can .But your reading must be active .It means that you must think about the structure, unfamiliar words etc as you read. There is no need that you stick to some complicated grammar structures or try to undestand all the unfamiliar words you come across, but the fact that you see them for the first time and recognize them whenever you see them for example in other phrases or books is enough. It would be better to prepare yourself a notebook so you can write down the important words or structures in it .This is the very useful methods of learning language. To begin reading , I recommend the easy reading books step by step. They classified by level of difficulty.

2) Listening

As for listening ,there are two options:

- ☑ Aside from reading , you can listen every day for about 30 minutes.
- ☑ You can only concentrate on your reading and become skillful at your reading , then you can catch up on your listening .

Listening ,one of the means of language communication is used most widely in people's daily lives. In addition, a lot of listening activities is a good way of enlargement your vocabulary On the other hand, it also helps you to improve your listening comprehension .So when you are skillful and native-like at reading , your listening skill grows automatically . Since you have lots of inputs in your mind , you can easily guess what the speaker is going to say . This never means that you should not practice listening. Practice is important . Only through the practice you can improve your listening. For listening , I recommend cartoons, moves, songs and radio programmes. Again the thing to remember is being active in listening and preferably taking some notes .

If you follow these pieces of advice, with your reading and listening skills your speaking and writing will be improved automatically, and you can be sure that with a little effort they will become perfect.

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
