

MODERN METHODS AND TIPS OF LEARNING ENGLISH

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Abstract: *This article talks about several methods of teaching and learning English. Those methods mentioned are more traditional. Therefore, the author also shares some tips of learning English independently. She cited these techniques within six options.*

Key words: *method, approach, language, English, Pimsleur, self-study, motivation, goal, schedule.*

English is currently the most popular and widespread international language in all countries of the world. It is studied in educational institutions, but many people study this language on their own. There are many methods for learning and memorizing words that help you learn a language on your own, but there are also some conditions for achieving the desired result that every person who wants to learn a foreign language should know about. The most important conditions for successful language learning are motivation, goal setting, a carefully planned language learning plan and free time to be dedicated to learning the language. [4] When choosing a learning methodology, it is important to correctly understand the level of your language proficiency, calculate financial opportunities and free time, and you also need to have a desire to learn a foreign language. All these factors are decisive in choosing a methodology for studying and achieving the desired level of the language.

There are many methods of learning English, in which the main role is played by memorizing as many words as possible, in this article we will analyze the most common of them. One of them is the "memory" method.

The second method of memorization is called "mnemonics", with the help of which it is possible to memorize words while creating vivid images in the head. For example, *spoon* - a spoon, to memorize this word, it is enough to imagine that *Spoon is some kind of sweetness that is in a spoon*. As the practice and experience of many foreign language teachers shows, the most common and effective way is to memorize words from cards. It consists of creating cards, on one side of which words are written in English, and on the other - the translation of these words into Uzbek. It is important in this technique to regularly repeat the recorded words and phrases at any opportunity. The next method is marking. The learning technique - in this method is to write down words from your environment on sticky notes and adhere them on the appropriate subjects, thus memorizing a large number of words. Ways of learning a

language are divided into classical, group, individual lessons with a tutor and self-study [2].

The Pimsleur method is based on the perception of the English language by ear. To date, the Pimsleur course is one of the best audio materials for learning this language. The method is based on immersing the student in the language environment while listening to materials and becoming a participant in full-fledged dialogues. The result is achieved by repeating phrases after the speaker and mastering new vocabulary and grammatical construction [1].

The method of Ilya Frank includes in its process breaking up the entire text in the original into small paragraphs with small inserts of the Uzbek translation. First, the student reads the lines with the translation, and then completely in the original language. Person can learn foreign languages independently. So there are several options that help people to obtain foreign language without attending different courses or lessons, but independently.

First - Set a specific goal.

It is on your learning goal that all further actions for self-study of the English language depend. Think about whether you want to learn conversational or business English, prepare for an interview or watch films in the original. A great goal is to reach the intermediate level, in which case you will lay down a good knowledge base.

Second - Schedule your classes.

It would seem that the beauty of self-study lies precisely in the fact that your English classes are not tied to any particular moment: you learn the language when it is convenient for you. However, in reality it turns out as in a well-known anecdote. Your conscience torments you: *"When will you sit down for English?"* And you answered her: *"Well, no, today I can't, I'm so tired. Let's never. Will it ever suit you?"* Agree, with this approach, it is impossible to learn English. Therefore, take a tight rein on yourself and make a schedule of classes, for example, study for an hour daily or 3-4 times a week for 1.5 hours.

Third - Select the required resources.

The abundance of useful resources does not always have a positive effect on learning. Many people decide to learn English and in one day they buy all available textbooks, bookmark 541 English learning websites, install 37 language learning apps. On the one hand, such zeal is commendable. On the other hand, each textbook and each site has its own principles for presenting the material, therefore, daily studying on different resources, you risk creating a mess in your head and in a week or two you won't know what to do. Below we offer you a list of good time-tested resources for learning English. Take a couple of days to choose no more than 2 resources to practice each skill [3].

Fourth - Look for an interlocutor.

There are those who believe that English can be mastered autonomously, using only books, audio and video materials. However, it is not. You can read Agatha Christie
