One of the demands placed on today's teachers is that they know well the methods applied to the educational process, which have passed the world's experience and are effective, and are able to apply them in practice.

For this, it is necessary for the teacher to constantly search, learn and test what he has learned, and himself to creatively change and make additions to these methods.

Many educational methods are used to organize the educational process, among which interactive education and the interactive methods that form its basis are

considered particularly effective. Below we will discuss some of the interactive methods used in teaching English.

The words interactive and interactive have the same meaning, and the word interactive is derived from the English words "inter" - "together" and "act" - "movement". Interactivity means being with something (such as a computer) or someone (a teacher) in a co-moving or conversational mode. It follows that interactive education is primarily dialogic education, during which the teacher and student, student and computer interact.

The basis of interactive education is conducting a lesson based on interactive methods, as mentioned above. Interactive methods of education make it possible to use and activate the enormous educational power of students, to introduce elements of competition into the educational process: the mental strength of a group of learners is greater than the sum of the strength of its members (that is, the group the result is always more than the sum of individual results).

Methods of understanding new material  
Methods of allowing thinking about what has been learned

The methods of encouraging learning can be used in the teaching of almost all subjects taught in the general secondary education system. can be achieved. For this, the teacher himself should have an understanding of the application of the above methods. Methods such as free writing, cluster, brainstorming, B-B-B drawing, sequence of confused logical chains, Blitz-question quickly attract students and increase their activity in the lesson. In Russian lessons, these methods should be used first in a simple form, and later in a more complex form, in accordance with the age of the students. Lessons organized using these methods are effective in both primary and upper grades.

During the lesson, the teacher comes from the class system of the students In this case, he should send them interesting and educational videos in English, 3 or 5 minutes long. of these videos if the duration is long, it may bore some students or some of them may not understand the words.

For this reason, it is desirable that the duration of the videos be short. It is possible to draw students' attention to language learning by showing videos to students in class. Effective results can be achieved by posting new topics, information, grammar rules, interesting information, poetry, vocabulary or videos about historical and famous people. In particular, students develop skills such as listening, listening comprehension, memorization, and speaking.

The methods of understanding new material are methods aimed at students' mutual cooperation in mastering science, learning by asking teachers and friends what they don't know and don't understand, and teaching others. These methods are considered effective not only intellectually, but also educationally, that is, these methods form feelings of friendship, honesty, kindness among students.

Reflection methods are methods that determine the extent to which students have mastered a new topic. By using them, students develop skills such as independent thinking and the ability to compare the knowledge they have learned.

Designing and applying these methods in the educational process based on the purpose and content of the lesson leads to the following results:

- \* students' interest and motivation to study increases;
- \* learners are prevented from getting bored and tired in class.
