They have sought out ways to learn and further develop traditional language teaching and modern teaching strategies.

**Main part:** We know that there are many technical ways to learn and teach English. However, it is not necessary to use only one method to eliminate the student's interest in learning the language. Therefore, it is possible to pay attention to various methods and techniques. It is necessary to use various other methods to avoid similar problems.

1. Learning English by watching movies. One of the most effective ways to learn a language is precisely through meeting requirements that include watching films, listening to their commentaries, taking notes and translating them. This method not only increases learning opportunities, but also leads to better understanding, communication and broader outlook. -“Brainstorming”- This method provides an opportunity for students to form groups and interact with each other. Through this approach, assigned tasks are divided into multiple stages, such as effectively allocating time, creating focused plans, and engaging students in classroom activities. It is considered as a method to facilitate group formation and improve the student learning experience.

-“Quiz cards” In this technical method, students are provided with special cards and given time to answer. The students interact with each other to advance their learning. This provides students with the opportunity to gain practical experience in the classroom at the same time.

According to the writings of J.Jalolov on teaching English in a modern way, it is emphasized that two methods should be used to teach grammar to students:

- 1) Inductive method - Rules are taught to students first, then examples are given.
- 2) Deductive method - First, examples are given, then rules are taught. When teaching language to young children, it is important to first pay attention to colors and shapes.

-.Group Story technology. This technology is implemented in 2 different ways. Firstly, each student adds a sentence to a story. A certain time limit is given and after the time is up, the resulting story is combined. In the second method, a subject is chosen and the teacher asks questions in a particular order, and every participating student writes down their answers. Nobody sees the written answers. This activity takes place in a loop.

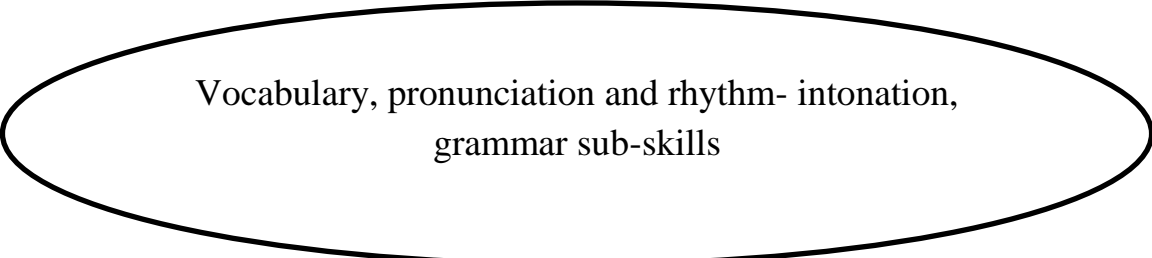

students' speech activity. Listening is the receptive form of speech. Repeating what has been heard without analyzing it makes listening almost impossible.

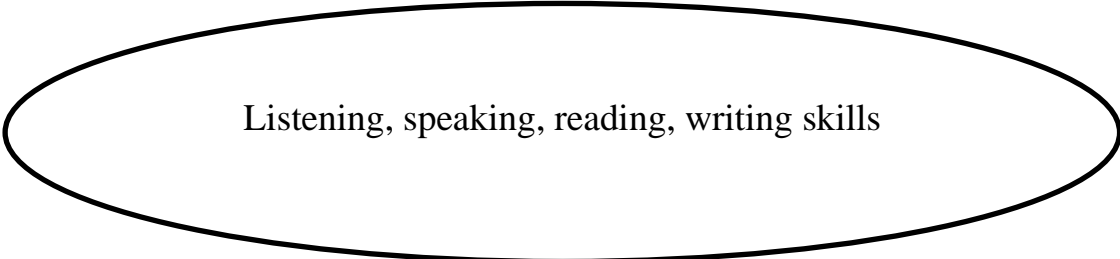
