Corpus linguistics suggests that reliable analysis of a language is best accomplished with corpora collected in the domain of that language's natural context ("realia") with the least amount of empirical intervention.

Currently, the field of linguistic corpora is one of the developing and highly needed fields for the present era. In language learning or teaching, corpus linguistics helps to explain the extent to which vocabulary is used, which words are grammatically connected, and which words have the potential to be used.

We know that in language teaching, explaining the lesson with examples relevant to the topic makes it easier for learners to master the topic well. This is where corpora help, meaning that a language learner can find compelling, fresh examples of a topic in a corpora.

As a result, the teacher gets an interesting and understandable lesson. In addition, in education, corpus is important for language learners to know the difference between a language learner and a native speaker, to compare language styles in books, textbooks.
