

## PREVENTION OF DISABILITIES ARISING OUT OF MARRIAGE BETWEEN RELATIVES

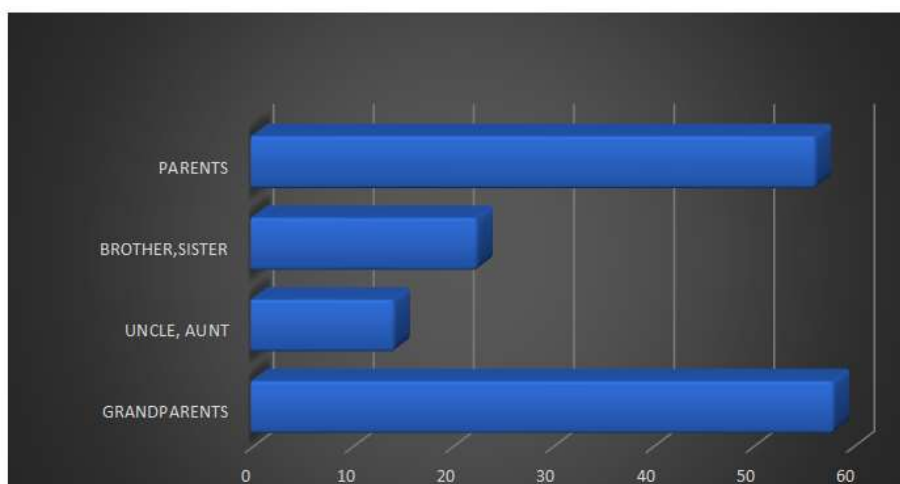
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Family is a sacred place. The main task of the family is to connect the chain of humanity with healthy and talented generations. Marriage is a specific union between a man and a woman, and it is a historical form of recognition and approval of this union by society and the state. As the first president of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Islam Abduganievich Karimov, noted: "The family is the center of education that ensures the eternity of life, continuity of generations, the sacred traditions of our people are polished, and directly affects the maturity of the next generation." On April 30, 1998, the Family Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan was approved by the Oliy Majlis. About 50 family-related laws and about 90 decrees, decisions and orders have been adopted. According to Article 63 of our Constitution, "The family is the main link of society and has the right to be under the protection of the state and society." "Marriage is based on the voluntary consent of the parties and equal rights." Also, in the Family Code, related principles such as early marriage and forced marriage are defined within the framework of the law. Marriage not only perpetuates the human race, but also ensures its honor and greatness, and is considered the main tool for the unity of society. Marriage should be approached after careful consideration, because it is necessary to interpret it on the right basis in order not to harm those around you. After all, the strength of the family is a means of maintaining the strength of the society. Nowadays, there are a lot of cases of marriage between relatives in order to be closer to close relatives. In particular, according to Article 16 of the Family Code, it is forbidden to enter into marriages between closely related relatives, between biological and step-brothers and sisters, and between adopters and adoptees.

According to the information of the civil registry office, between July and December 2021, a total of 1,210 close relatives marriages are recorded. (529 between aunts' children-paternal, 307 between uncles' children-paternal, 178 between aunts' children-maternal, 196 between uncles' children-maternal). In terms of regions, more than half of the marriages concluded between relatives, 59 percent, correspond to two regions: Surkhandarya (343) and Kashkadarya (371). The number of children born with disabilities, including children with congenital anomalies, deformities and chromosomal disorders under the age of 1, is increasing. In particular, the number of children with disabilities under 1 year of age increased from 2592 in 2018 to 3374 in 2020, or 30.1 percent, and the number of congenital anomalies (developmental defects), deformities and chromosomal disorders under 1 year of age increased from 1093 in 2018 to 1292 in 2020, or 18 increased by 2 percent. "This is the reason for the strengthening of negative

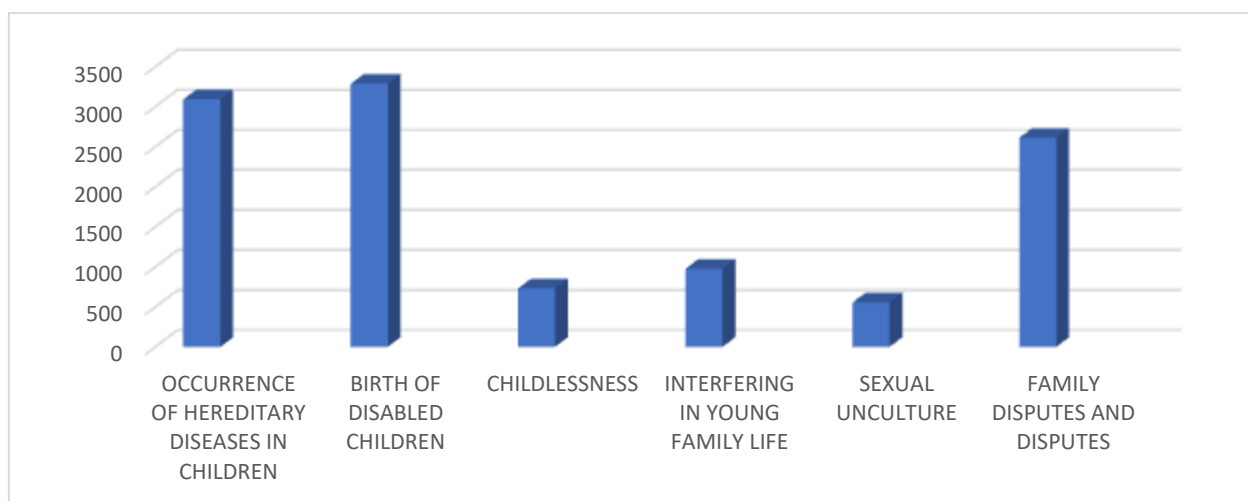
demographic trends in the country, the emergence of new problems related to the issues of socialization of such children." In order to study the cases of consanguineous marriages and their causes, in a sociological survey conducted among the chairmen of 6,974 neighborhood assemblies in 200 districts of our country, the respondents to the question aimed at determining how the lives of consanguineous families are going 25.2% of respondents said that there are enough conflicts and disputes, 24.9% of respondents said that such families have disabled children, but they live by fate, 8.9% of the participants said that the situation in families built on the basis of kinship is difficult, there are many problems, they reported that there are constant disagreements in the family. 10.8 percent of those who fully support marriage relations between relatives, and 26.0 percent of those who support it as an ordinary situation. At the same time, 34.9% of the respondents said that they do not support marriage between relatives, while the highest rate corresponded to Kashkadarya region (45.1%). In addition, 5.7% of the respondents had difficulty answering the question: express your attitude towards marriage between relatives. Most of those who marry between relatives say that they started a family for various reasons, for example: to further strengthen kinship relations and to protect property from falling into the hands of outsiders. However, experts in this field advise that starting a family with relatives does not lead to good results. In May-June 2021, a sociological survey was conducted among the chairmen of 6974 community assemblies in 200 districts of the republic in order to study the cases of marriage between relatives and its reasons. According to the results of the research, 46.1% of the respondents stated that the main reason for the marriages between relatives was to maintain kinship ties, 43.5% of the participants were not to give good girls and boys among relatives to strangers, and 23.6% were to protect the family's wealth, not leaving property to strangers and economic interest, as well as 19.7 percent of parents noted that they think about their well-being in old age. According to the results of the research, 58.1% of the respondents to the question aimed at determining the initiator of marriage between relatives, 56.4% were parents, 14.3% were uncles and aunts. , 13.2 percent answered that they were sisters, 1.2 percent were brothers, and 8.3 percent were other persons.

Marriage between relatives, the birth of disabled children (48.2 percent of respondents), the occurrence of hereditary diseases in children (45.4 percent of respondents), family conflicts and disagreements, coldness between relatives, and the breakdown of kinship ties. (38.4 percent of respondents), excessive interference of two parties in many issues in the life of young brides and grooms (14.3 percent of respondents) and childlessness (10.7 percent of respondents) are cited as the cause of negative consequences. The increase in negative consequences such as the birth of disabled children and the occurrence of genetic diseases in children as a result of a marriage between relatives is a sufficient reason to stay away from such marriages. Many social consequences, such as coldness between relatives due to difficult situations, problems, family conflicts and disagreements in families, can also cause us to abandon marriages between relatives.

In conclusion, it is permissible to say that; in 2022-2023, the number of children with disabilities under the age of 1 grew from 3,374 to 3,582. As a result of such marriages, 25.6 percent of the population have disabilities and hereditary diseases in children. The population of Jizzakh region (28.8%) is suffering and many families are losing their child right in the delivery room after hearing about the birth of a disabled child, we need to explain about possible genetic diseases. But in the occurrence of congenital disability lies the relative influence of parents. As a result, everyone suffers, especially the innocent baby. Also, the death of the foetus from the marriage between close relatives, the death of the baby in the first months, and the birth with mental weakness are increasing day by day. In order to prevent this, it is necessary to feel responsibility for the future, not only to protect the disabled, but also to fight with the reasons that cause disability. Every child has the right to live a full life.

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
